



**Ratification of the First Amended Renewal and Continuation of Declaration of Local Disaster and Public Health Emergency Related to Communicable Disease, Proclaimed and Ordered on March 25, 2020.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 24, 2020, I, Ronnie Spradlin, as Mayor of the City of Kilgore, Texas, issued a Local Disaster and Public Health Emergency Declaration for the City of Kilgore resulting from the global pandemic of the novel coronavirus designated SARS-CoV2 which causes the disease COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 25, 2020, Gregg County Judge Bill Stoudt signed the First Amended Renewal and Continuation of Declaration of Local Disaster and Public Health Emergency Related to Communicable Disease; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating the aforesaid Declaration continue to exist; and

**WHEREAS**, the city limits of Kilgore extend into both Gregg and Rusk Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to provide consistent guidance and services to the entire Kilgore community it is necessary to ratify this order for both the Gregg and Rusk County portions of Kilgore.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF KILGORE, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the document titled, "First Amended Renewal and Continuation of Declaration of Local Disaster and Public Health Emergency Related to Communicable Disease," proclaimed and ordered by Gregg County Judge Bill Stoudt on March 25, 2020 is hereby ratified for the entire incorporated limits of the City of Kilgore.

**SECTION 2.** That all provisions of this Order shall become effective at 11:59 pm on March 26, 2020 and shall continue in effect until 11:59 pm on April 9, 2020.
